## Championship Matches

# Champions will be determined at each individual site. <br> We will not go to one court site for the championships. 

## Management

1. All tournament play will follow USTA rules and the district's code of conduct. No foul language, racquet smashing/throwing, ball pounding, uncooperative behavior or any other unsportsmanlike conduct ON or OFF the court.
(Verbal warning will be given to all players at the beginning of the tournament Friday morning)
a. $1^{\text {st }}$ violation: Loss of point
b. $2^{\text {nd }}$ violation: Loss of game
c. $3^{\text {rd }}$ violation: Loss of match
2. Players MUST check in upon arrival to the courts in the morning and check with the coach in charge before they leave to get food.
3. Warm-Ups: 10 minute warm-up for the first match and 5 minutes for all matches that follow.
4. Default: Players that do not report to the courts 10 minutes after the first match is called will be defaulted.
a. We must keep the tournament running and it is not the job of the coach in charge to track down players when it is their time to go on the court.
5. Coaching is allowed between each change-over if necessary. Cannot exceed $11 / 2$ minutes.

## Tennis Balls:

- Every team needs to bring 15 cans of balls for the matches.
- Tennis balls can be used for at least 2 matches before they need to be changed out with new balls. Coaches in charge should keep track of this and replace used tennis balls when appropriate.
- If all goes well we should have enough tennis balls to take care of the entire tournament.

Scoring:

- 4 game pro-set with NO-Ad scoring in all matches. - up for discussion (per HC meeting)
- 12 point tiebreaker at 4-4


## Order of Play:

- All of the matches will be round robin. The team with the most wins is the champion. Ties are based on head-to-head matches. Like last year there is no championship round.
- Make sure that all round robin matches are properly input, listing game scores and NOT just W/L.
- Round Robin Points:
- 2 pts for a win
- 1 pt for a loss
- 0 for a forfeit
- Place ties will be determined by head-to-head match outcome in the pool play.
- 3 way ties will be broken by the least number of games lost.
- Report Match Scores throughout the day to the Coach of the Host School. Awards: Team $\mathbf{1}^{\text {st }}$ and $\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}$ Place Trophies awarded for each event.
